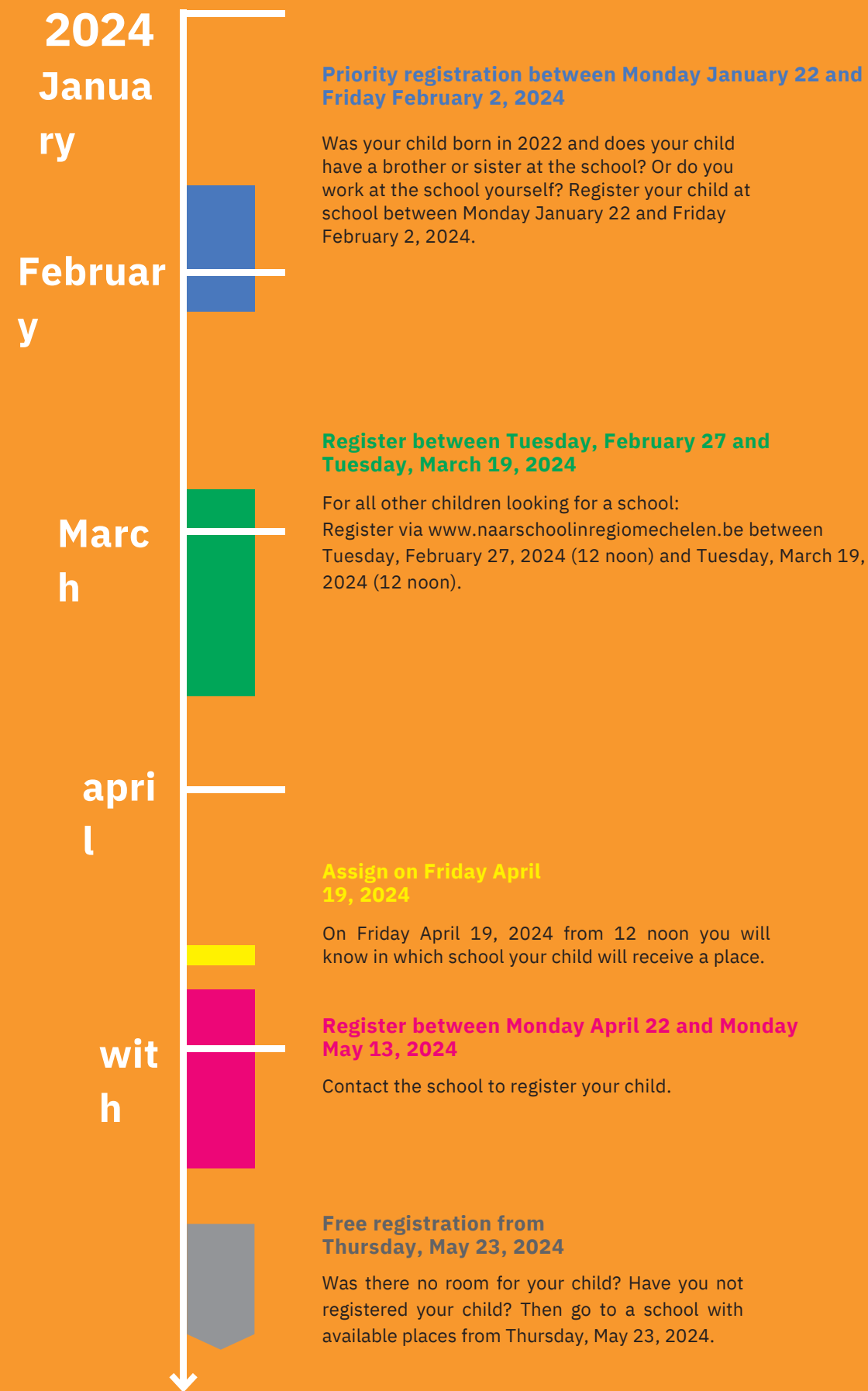

Register first, then register

How can you register your child in a school of your preference?

Was your child born in 2022 and does your child have a brother or sister at the school? Or do you work at the school yourself?

- > Register your child for the entry-level class at the school itself between Monday January 22 and Friday February 2, 2024. **You no longer have to register digitally afterwards!**

In all other cases:

1. Register via www.naarschoolinregiomechelen.be between February 27, 2024 (12 noon) and March 19, 2024 (12 noon).

o'clock). There is no time pressure. The time at which you register your child has no influence on the distribution

of the free places as long as you register within this period.

2. You will receive the result on April 19, 2024 from 12 noon.

You will receive a notification of this by email.

3. Go to your assigned school between April 22 and May 13, 2024 to register your child.

Registration takes place at school. Please note: do not do this then your place will be forfeited!

4. Was there no room for your child? From May 23, 2024, you will go to a school with places still available. You can find more information on www.naarschoolinregiomechelen.be.

Benefits of registering?

- > You can indicate multiple schools in the order of your preference.
- > In the schools you choose, we sort the children partly based on the distance 'home - school' or the distance 'parents' workplace - school'; and partly by chance.
- > You increase your chances of getting a place at a school of your preference.

TIPS

- Visit the school's website.
- Check if there are additional visiting times.
- Do you have any questions? Be sure to contact the school!

WHICH CHILDREN?

- > All children born in 2022. Even if they are babysitting can go to school on September 1, 2025.
- > Children who want to change schools.
- > Was your child born in 2022 and does he or she have a brother or sister? Or does one of the parents work at the school? Register your child at the school between January 22 and February 2, 2024. You are then guaranteed your place!

WHICH SCHOOLS?

for mainstream primary education in Somerden, Mechelen, Sint-Katelijne-Waver and Zemst.

Even if the school of your first choice always offers all learning

If you were unable to register, we recommend that you register your child in advance via the website www.naarschoolinregiomechelen.be. The situation may even be reversed.

WHY REGISTER?

Primary schools that have to refuse students due to limited capacity are required by the government to work with a registration system.

HOW DO I REGISTER?

Register = equal opportunities for every child!

By registering, every child has an equal opportunity to enroll in a school of their choice. The place your child receives will be the highest preferred school as much as possible.

Special education report

In order to go to special education, an IAC report from the Center for Student Guidance (CLB) is required; This report states the type of special education.

The CLB does not simply hand out a report. This requires research and advice.

So contact the CLB that supervises your child's current school in a timely manner.

The CLB and the school work together to find the best solution for your child.

What does the Center for Student Guidance do? (CLB)

A center for student guidance helps you with questions about education, health, learning and development, well-being in the school or classroom.

CLBs work on demand, so you can contact the CLB yourself.

Register via www.naarschoolinregiomechelen.be between April 15, 2024 (12 noon) and May 3, 2024 (12 noon). Select "Register for Special Primary Education" on the website. Be guided by the CLB and/or your current school.

Frequently Asked Questions

When to register?

Register your child between Tuesday, February 27 (12 noon) and Tuesday, March 19 (12 noon) 2024.

No time pressure!

There is no time pressure. The time at which you register your child has no influence on the distribution of free places. You register during the designated period.

How to register quickly?

To ensure that registration runs smoothly, you need your child's national register number. You can find this at:

> ISI+-kaart,



> or on the sticky note from the health insurance company,



> or on the kids ID.



Does your child not have a national register number? Contact an information point (see p. 10 and 11).

To register you need a computer, smartphone or tablet with internet.

Do you not have a computer, smartphone or tablet or do you not have an internet connection? Contact an information point (see p. 10 and 11).

How to register?

Complete the digital form at www.naarschoolinregiomechelen.be. Please take your time to fill in all the requested information. Fill in this information truthfully. If you deliberately provide incorrect information, the registration will become invalid.

Which schools to apply for?

You can choose from all schools for regular nursery and primary education in Bonheiden, Mechelen, Sint-Katelijne-Waver and Zemst. School preference is followed as much as possible.

How to organise?

At some schools, the demand for free places is greater than the supply. If there is a shortage of space, priority will be given to:

- > first to brothers and sisters and children of staff;
- > then partly to the children who live closest to the school or whose parents work closest to the school and partly to the children who were ranked first by chance.

Why register?

More and more schools are quickly filling up. We want to guarantee a place for every child. And as close as possible where it lives. So that children have the opportunity to go to school within walking distance.

Can I register my child at multiple schools?

Yes. There is no limit. It increases your chance of getting into a school of your preference.

How can I see if there is still room for my child?

When you register, you will see for each school how many free places there are left for your child's age group at the start of the registration period. You can also find this information at www.naarschoolinregiomechelen.be.

Which school do I put first?

Put the school you would most like your child to attend first. Even if there are few or no free places at the time of registration. Perhaps your child will be ranked favorably or a place will become available later.

This is possible even if your child is already enrolled in another school.

The school will contact you if a place becomes available. Place the school you want most at the top. Then your second choice, then your third choice, ... Be guided only by your personal preference. (Last year, 91% of entrants had a place in their first choice school.)

Do people who register for me via the internet have a better chance of getting a place?

No. When registering, the time does not matter, as long as it happens within the planned period.

What should I do if I want to change something during the registration period?

Log in again to the registration system and adjust your details. Does this not work? Please contact LOP expert Annigie Claes (lop.regiomechelen@vlaanderen.be or 02 553 06 10).

I don't have a computer, what can I do?

Contact one of the information points (see p. 10 and 11).

Can I be assigned a school that is not on my list?

No. We only look at the schools that you have chosen yourself and that are on your list. In order to prevent If your child does not have a place, it is best to fill in all the schools you prefer. The more schools you enter, the better your chance of getting a place.

What happens if I don't register my child?

Then you can still look for a place from Tuesday, May 23, 2024, but many schools will be full. We recommend that you definitely register!

Which criteria influence the allocation of a school?

> whether or not you belong to a priority group (brother/sister or child of staff) > distance > coincidence The schools make annual agreements about this within the local consultation platform (LOP).

Do brothers and sisters have priority when registering?

Brothers and sisters have priority. They must also be registered during the registration period.

If my child is registered, is my child also registered?

No. After your child has been registered, you must still go to the school between April 22 and May 13, 2024 to register your child. Please note: if you do not do this, your place will be forfeited!

What do I take with me when I go to the school to register my child?

> The kids ID or another official document (for example from Fedasil or a document showing family composition).

Do I choose entry-level class or first kindergarten class?

A child born in 2022 must register for the entry-level class. A child born in 2021 must register for the first kindergarten class.

When can my toddler start school?

From the moment your child is 2.5 years old, he can start in the

Who can register my child?

Only persons with parental authority can register. These are the parents (father and mother) or a guardian. Grandparents or foster parents have no parental authority and can only register the child with a power of attorney from the parents or guardian.

What happens if my child is enrolled in school?

1. The school checks your child's details.
2. You declare that you agree with the school's pedagogical project and the school regulations.
3. You place a signature on the student sheet.
4. You will receive a registration certificate.

What if my child did not get a free place?

1. The school will record your child's name in the registration register.
2. Your child will receive a ranking number and you will receive a "unrealized registration" document. Your child is now on the school's waiting list. For children born in 2022, the school must have this ranking number respect until June 30, 2025. For children who were born earlier, the school must have this ranking number

respect until the fifth school day in October 2024.

Do you have questions? Do you need help?

Do you have a question about the registration system? Don't have a smartphone, tablet or computer with internet? Do you need help with digital registration?

The organizations listed on this page can help you with your search for a school. Even if you are unable to register and register, they will be happy to help you. You can of course also ask for help from family, neighbors and the schools themselves.
